## FWFS President's Report 2015 - 2016

We are thankful to be celebrating the completion of our second official year as the Friends of the Waltham Family School, Inc.; and it has been a wonderful year! Here are some highlights:

- Thanks to the generosity of so many, the total amount of donations have doubled over the past year; we received our first ever multi-year commitment, a three-year pledge from the Park Lodge Hotel Group.
- We had our most successful Fiesta! for WFS yet. For the second time gathering at Solea restaurant, we expanded the number of attendees, raised over \$25,000, and had the opportunity to publicly express our gratitude to the Park Lodge Hotel group. At the Fiesta, we were also able to share the story of the "fabulous five," the first five Waltham High School graduates who were members of the first WFS preschool class in 2003. Also, we will continue to offer opportunities for *Coffee and Conversation* as a way of initiating and strengthening connections through inviting donors, community leaders, Brandeis and Bentley supporters, and corporate sponsors to engage with current WFS parents and see the school in action. 
